

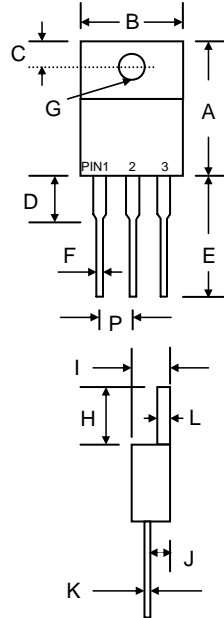

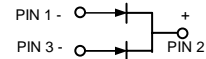

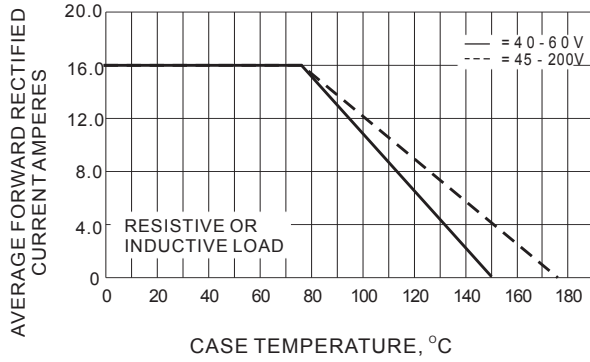


Fig.1- FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

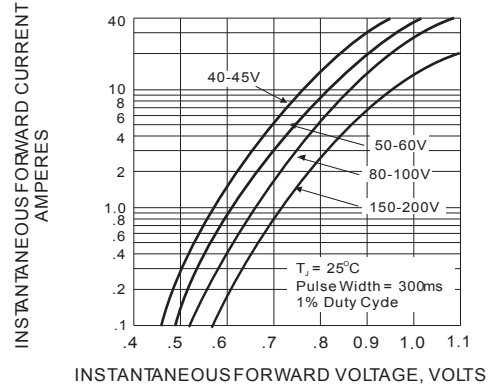


Fig.2- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

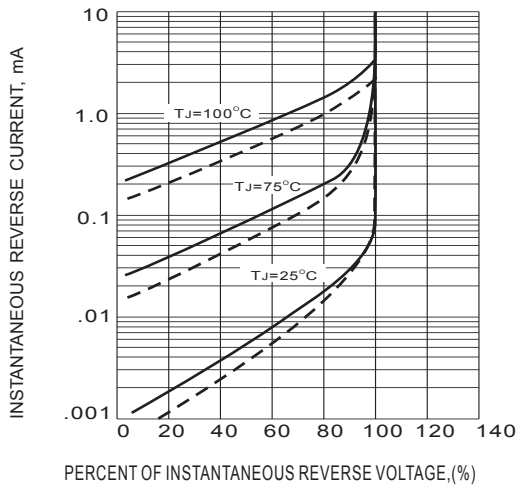


Fig.3- TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

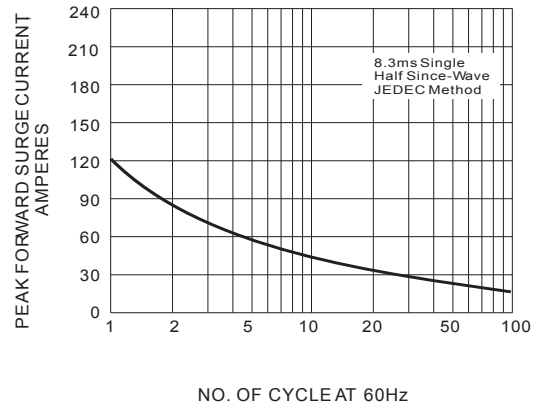


Fig.4- MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE SURGE CURRENT
